

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a program where the farmer packs a weekly bag of fresh-picked produce and has it ready for the CSA member to pick up. While the CSA member does not choose what is in the bag, they get a great assortment of fresh produce every week and are likely to try new items. We grow over 40 varieties of produce and try to include at least 4 different items each week in your bag. It forces the CSA member to think out-side-of-the-box when it comes to meal planning. Members find they are eager to try new recipes and stop making the same meals over and over. Even the kids learn to try new items since it comes from "their" farm. Great recipes and storage ideas are included. Past members say they look forward to getting a surprise each week and they become creative in the kitchen.

Our CSA Season runs for 18 weeks beginning June 21 thru October 22nd 2017.

Basic Share: Cost \$220

The basic share is a weekly blue bag of fresh produce that generally will feed two to three people.

After choosing the basic share, you can add any of the following options:

Extra Goodies: Cost \$230

This bag will come *every other week* alongside your Basic Share Bag. The special Extra Goodies Bag will contain 1 dozen farm fresh eggs, 1 package of Jisa or other local cheese, 1 loaf of Great Harvest bread, 1 jar of jelly/honey or other type of spread, and one surprise item.

Herb Package: Cost \$50

This package will come *every other week* alongside your Basic Share Bag. You can expect enough herbs to use fresh and have some left for drying. Recipe ideas are included. We are growing basil, thyme, oregano, parsley, cilantro, dill, chives, sage and rosemary.

Harvest Tickets: Cost \$50

If you like large amounts of produce for preserving, this option is a must! You will receive 5 tickets. Each ticket can be redeemed for a bucket of produce. If everything grows as planned, you will be able to redeem your tickets for buckets of any of the following items: tomatoes, green beans, onions, broccoli, beets, cucumbers, peppers, rhubarb, zucchini, acorn, butternut and spaghetti squash or redeem one ticket for two dozen sweetcorn. We will notify you as items become available in large quantities (usually beginning in August). Some items may be "you pick".

Gift Certificate Package: Cost \$225.00

Instead of getting the Basic Share, you can choose the Gift Certificate Package and shop at the farm.

Get \$250 worth of gift certificates for only **\$225!** Choose the produce you want and don't be afraid to try new things! Certificates can be used for *any* items in our farm store including items in our meat and pie freezer. Use the certificates yourself or give them as gifts. All certificates must be used at our farm store during the 2017 CSA Season.

<u>Delivery Options</u>: We are able to deliver to your work if you have at least fifteen participating employees. Depending on location, we may be able to deliver with fewer than 15 participants. Please call us to discuss options.

Otherwise, you can choose to pick up at one of our designated locations in Downtown, Midtown, Bellevue, Rock brook, Ralston, 156th & West Dodge Road, Village Pointe or at our farm in Irvington. **Cost for delivery is a one-time per season fee of \$15 per person**. Members picking up at the farm do not pay a delivery charge.

Final Payment is due by June 1.

Early Bird Incentive: If paid in-full by April 10th, get a \$10 credit to use in our greenhouse during the month of May.

To get an idea of what might be in a bag, the following are contents of bags that were delivered in 2016. They will come in a blue reusable bag that you wash and return each week when you pick up your new bag.

- Week 1: head of green leaf lettuce, 1 large bunch broccoli, 2 cucumbers, 1 slicing tomato
- Week 2: 2 zucchini, 3 yellow summer squash, 5 peaches, 1 quart of baby red potatoes
- Week 3: 6 bi-color sweet corn, 2 cucumbers, 5 peaches, 1 kohlrabi, 1 bunch of kale
- Week 4: 1 quart of Yukon gold potatoes, 2 tomatoes, 1 large red onion, 3 leeks, 2 zucchini
- Week 5: Six ears Amy's Gold Sweetcorn, 2 Asian striped zucchini, 1 quart green beans, 2 yellow onions, 1 cucumber
- Week 6: half dozen white sweet corn, 1 large head cabbage, 1 kohlrabi
- Week 7: 1 quart beets, 1 quart green beans, 1 quart red potatoes, 3 peaches, 2 tomatoes
- Week 8: 1 large cantaloupe, 2 cucumbers, 6 peaches, half dozen sweet corn
- Week 9: 3 bell peppers, 3 red onions, 1 yellow onion, 1 cucumber, 2 green tomatoes for frying, spaghetti squash
- Week 10: 2 red bell peppers, 1 white onion, 10 jalapenos, 6 sweet corn, 2 cucumbers, 3 tomatoes
- Week 11: Acorn squash, 1 quart green beans, 5 peaches, 1 yellow bell pepper, 6 sweet corn
- Week 12: 5 apples, 1 head red cabbage, 1 bunch celery, 8 sweet banana peppers, and 3 leeks
- Week 14: 6 Italian Roasting Peppers, 2 red onions, eggplant, kale, butternut squash
- Week 15: 4 apples, 2 cucumbers, 1 spaghetti squash, 2 kohlrabi, 1 quart green beans, 1 bunch cauliflower
- Week 16: 3 bell peppers, 2 yellow onion, sweet potatoes, beets
- Week 17: Spaghetti squash, 1 quart Yukon gold potatoes, 1 head lettuce, 1 large white onion
- Week 18: Sweet Potatoes, Acorn Squash, Broccoli, Butternut squash.
